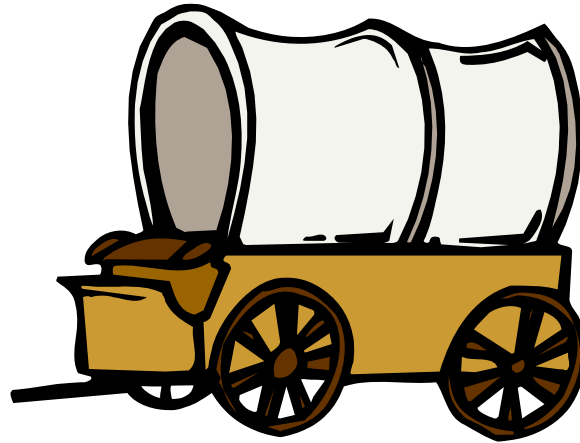


Laura Ingalls Wilder was a famous writer. She was born in Wisconsin in 1867. Her first book was printed over 70 years ago.

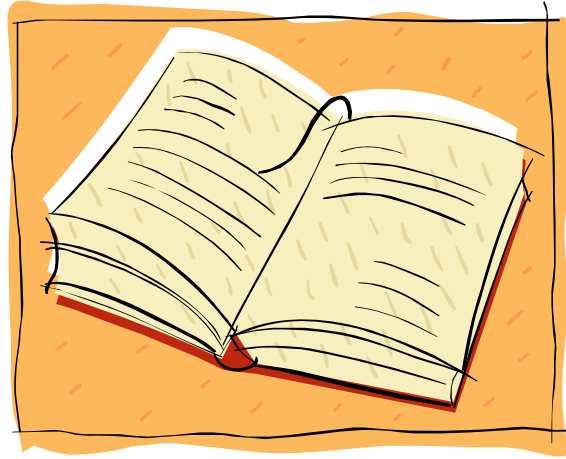

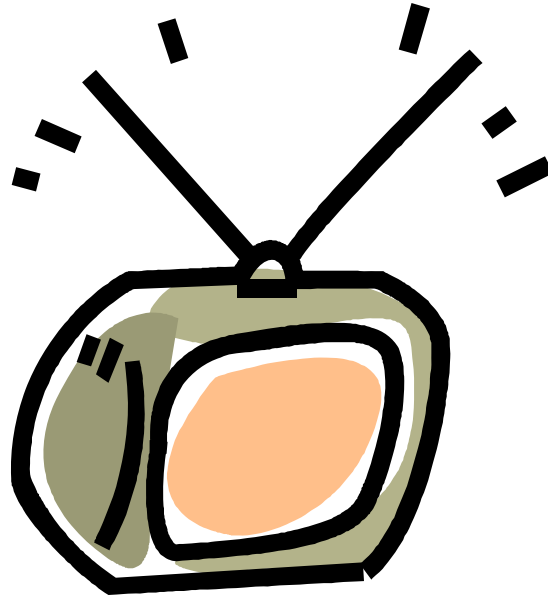
Laura's family traveled a lot. They rode in a covered wagon. They traveled through thick woods. They rode over dry lands.

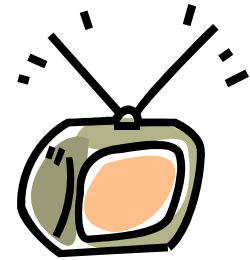
